The fifteen year old agencies community based services also include literacy enrichment, structured self-esteem workshops, mental health services, family preservation services and specialized training for foster and adoptive parents. April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month. In addition to our fundraising goals, the event is also designed to bring community attention, resources and action to the tragedy of child abuse.
